BUSINESS INCUBATOR

At CEI, businesses are given the space and support needed to help launch their innovative companies. Staff, partners, and advisors are available to help start-ups at each level of their growth. The business incubator not only provides the knowledge to launch a business, but offers professional marketing services to establish new businesses in the community.

THE CAPITAL CURE
